Workshop scan tools

In the digital era we live in scan tools like Carman, Autel and Jaltest are part of the essential equipment that workshops need in order to obtain vehicle information.

Having an automotive diagnostic scan tool has become a necessary investment for workshops as the vehicles become more and more computerised. A scan tool can range from \$490 as for example an OBDII quick service tool (Autel MD802 all systems or MaxicheckPro) to comprehensive tools equipped with hardware compatible with J2534 protocols that allow mechanics to perform deep level programming from \$3,500 like Carman i100/i700 (12V and 24V for cars and trucks, three-year free update) and Autel MaxisysPro (12V for car, one-year free update).

Nowadays all the scan tools are designed for online use, like online printing DTC reports. Technicians can use the tools to access an online data provider, like Boyce Data, to obtain vehicle information. Mechanics can update the software directly from the tool linking to a scanner server, or they can access the dealership website for deep programming licence prescription (for example the GM, ACDelco, etc).
